GEOGRAPHY AND ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT – Structured Degree which has a prescribed curriculum

The purpose of this interdisciplinary programme, offered on both the Howard and Pietermaritzburg Campuses, is to produce graduates who have a sound knowledge of, and training in, geography and environmental management. The degree is structured around core Geography, Environmental Sciences and Environmental

Management modules. Students' training involves exposure to a range of elective modules in social science disciplines complementary to the focus on environmental management.

GOVERNMENT, BUSINESS AND ETHICS – Structured Degree which has a prescribed curriculum

This degree curriculum is designed to combine training in the Government and Business fields with a strong foundation in Ethics and Applied Ethics. Participants in the programme will have the opportunity to develop an understanding of, *inter alia*, the nature, responsibilities and values of good citizenship, the importance of intellectual probity, critical thinking and analysis and the development of innovative research and learning techniques, the societal norms, values and varied cultures that shape domestic and global worlds, and ethics in the pursuit of a variety of entrepreneurial initiatives.
