MINIMUM Requirements for the Matric Point Score to apply for;

Bachelor of **Social Science (Augmented)** (4 years) = between 20 and 27 points (and applies to low quintile schools only)

Bachelor of **Arts (BA)** and **Social Science (BSocSc)** (3 years) = 28 points for admission to study

IMPORTANT: Your application is NOT guaranteed, as admission is dependent on available spaces at UKZN.

Majors in the General (BA and BSocSc) Degrees

A major is a specific compulsory module that is studied from first-year through to third-year.

The choice of majors is therefore very important, first-year and second-year students are advised to choose their subjects in such a way that they give themselves several possible options for majors. The major subjects will also determine whether a degree is a Bachelor of Arts or a Bachelor of Social Science.
