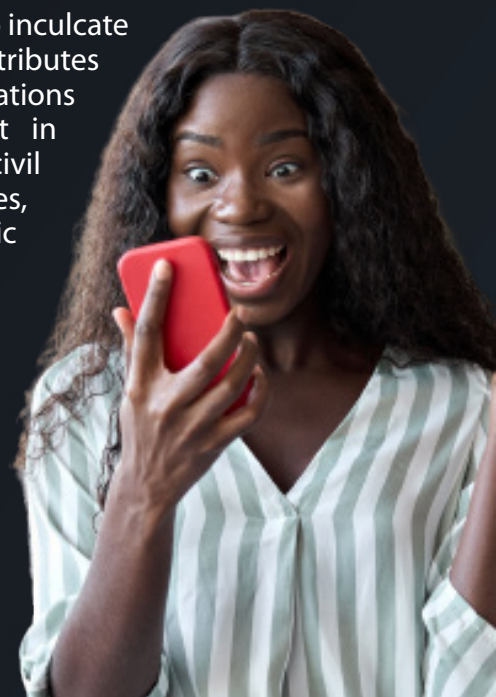
WHY STUDY WITH US?
